PEPS (Plumas Eureka Preservation Society), founded 18 years ago, is a non-profit organization dedicated to preserving and enhancing the physical environment and beauty of our community. Soon, PEPS will be busy with projects for 2017. From Plant Sales to Pine Needle Pick Up, we are on track for another busy year. As property owners and residents, our entire community benefits from these efforts. Read below what we accomplished last year, and plan to continue this year.

In 2016, PEPS accomplished the following:

- PEPS held a new event – a **Wine Walk** in the Enduring Freedom Garden! It was a huge success and plans are under way to hold it again this June. Friends and neighbors enjoyed wine, beer and appetizers, listened to live music, mingled with each other, and strolled through the garden.
- Planted and maintained the **Firehouse, Enduring Freedom and Ponderosa Gardens**. Much effort was put into the Enduring Freedom Garden with interesting perennials planted and a beautiful welcoming garden angel added to create a serene atmosphere. The Ponderosa garden is an enchanted garden with new perennials being planted throughout, complete with signage to identify every kind. Beautiful shade-loving rhododendrons were planted in the Firehouse Garden to make that garden “pop!” Of course, constant weeding happens throughout the summer.
- With the help of Plumas Pines golf course, PEPS continues its reintroduction of the beautiful **flower garden** at the first sight of the golf course **on Poplar Valley Road**.
- Planted and maintained the **flower barrels at the mailbox** clusters throughout the community.
- Held a **Plant Sale** on Memorial Day weekend, thinning our own garden-grown plants and selling them at very reasonable prices.
- Held our annual **Pine Needle Pick Up**, reducing smoke from burning pine needles and supporting fire prevention.
- Maintained 15 **Dog Waste Bag Dispensers** throughout Plumas Eureka Estates.
- Hosted our annual October general meeting and social **“Soup’s On” dinner** for over 100 neighbors.
- Strung LED Christmas lights at the Plumas Eureka Firehouse and held **Christmas Tree Lighting and Santa Visit** at that location on the weekend following Thanksgiving.
