

## SAMPLE PLANT GUIDE FOR PLUMAS-EUREKA AREA

(Refer to horticultural books for more information)

### SHADE PLANTS (or partial sun)

Bergenia (Saxifrage) 12" – 18" tall – flowers early - perennial  
Dicentra spectabilis (Bleeding Heart) – about 2' tall – blooms spring – perennial  
Digitalis (Foxglove) – up to 3' tall – blooms June/July – biennial  
Galium odoratum – (Sweet Woodruff) – perennial ground cover  
Helleborus (Christmas Rose) – up to 12" tall – blooms Dec-April – perennial  
Hosta (Plantain Lily) up to 2' tall-variegated leaves - perennial  
Hydrangea (Arborescens "grandiflora") – flowering deciduous shrub  
Impatiens up to 12" tall - flowers summer – usually annual  
Lamium maculatum (Spotted Dead Nettle) – 6"-8" tall - flowering ground cover  
Lobelia – up to 6" tall – flowers summer – annual  
Mertensia (Virginia Bluebell) - 1' – 2' tall - perennial  
Primula (Primroses) – up to 12" tall – blooms spring – perennial  
Rhododendrons (includes hardy azalea) – Shrub - blooms spring – choose frost hardy variety  
Trollius (Globe Flower) up to 2' tall – perennial  
Viburnum (Snowball) - Deciduous flowering shrub  
Vinca (Periwinkle) – Evergreen flowering ground cover  
Wisteria – vine – blooms April/May – choose hardy variety

### SUN (or part shade)

Ajuga reptans (Bugleweed) – flowers spring – perennial groundcover  
Aquilegia (Columbine) – up to 3' tall – perennial – starts flowering May/June  
Aster – up to 4' tall – blooms late summer/fall – perennial  
Clematis – vine - choose hardy variety  
Daffodil and Grape Hyacinth – bulbs – early spring flowers  
Delphinium – 3'-4' tall – perennial – blooms June/July  
Dianthus (Pinks/Sweet William) – perennial/biennial  
Echinacea (similar to Purple Coneflower) – 1'-2' tall – perennial  
Heuchera (Coral Bells) up to 2' tall – perennial  
Iberis (Candy Tuft) – annual & perennial varieties – flowers spring/summer  
Mahonia aquifolium (Oregon Grape) – shrub – yellow flowers, blue berries  
Paeonia (Peony) – up to 3' tall - blooms May/June – perennial  
Phlox – up to 4' – blooms July/August – perennial  
Syringa (Lilac) – shrub – 4'-10' tall  
Viola (Violets - Pansies) – several varieties – annual, biennial, perennial

### FULL SUN

Antirrhinum (Snapdragon) – hardy annual – 8" – 2' tall summer flowers  
Barberis (Barberry) – Hardy shrub – 3'-6' tall or dwarf 1'-2' tall  
Chaenomeles (Flowering Quince) – shrub, flowers spring  
Cinquefoil (Potentilla) – hardy shrub – yellow, white flowers – blooms summer till fall  
Cornus (Dogwood) – deciduous hardy shrub – has flowers and berries  
Euonymus (Burning Bush) – shrub 4'-5' tall – bright fall foliage  
Gaillardia (Blanket Flower) – perennial – 1' – 2' tall – flowers all summer  
Hemerocallis (Daylily) – perennial – 2'-3' tall – yellow/orange flowers July/Aug  
Iris – bulbs, rhizomes – 2' tall – blooms spring  
Lavandula (Lavender Spica) – evergreen shrub – fragrant flowers  
Parthenocissus (Virginia Creeper) – Vine – tiny flowers, berries, red fall foliage  
Petunia – annual – funnel shaped flowers- all summer – many colors  
Roses – choose hardy varieties  
Sedum – (Autumn Joy) – perennial – 2' tall -flowers late summer  
Spirea – shrub 2'-6' tall depending on variety – blooms spring/summer  
Tithonia (Mexican sunflower) to 4' high – perennial – blooms July – August
